Project is vital and DAP workshops are multi-day or week-long engagements, designed to be incorporated into conferences, trainings, or festivals. Specific engagements can be as long as eight weeks and as brief a single day, depending on the needs and scheduling restrictions of partnering organizations.

Shorter engagements of 1-2 days provide an introductory experience to the DAP philosophy and model, whereas longer commitments of several weeks or more are designed to produce more targeted and sustainable impact within the culture of a partnering organization.

Each DAP engagement looks slightly different depending on the needs of partnering organizations. Typically, all workshops involve one or more of the following service models:
